COVID-19 PROTOCOLS 2022

The following protocols are based on guidance from the Center for Disease Control (CDC), the American Camp Association (ACA) and the CT Office of Early Childhood (OEC). Parents and Camp Playland must work in tandem to create the safest environment for campers and staff. All protocols are subject to change.

FACE MASKS – Masks are not required on camp buses or during the camp day. If you prefer your camper(s) wear a mask, please let us know – counselors will support this. Camp will have disposable masks available.

VACCINATIONS – All Camp Playland counselors are up to date on COVID-19 vaccinations. Campers are not required to be vaccinated at this time.

ILL CAMPERS – If during the day campers / counselors are determined by the camp nurses to be ill with a stomach issue, respiratory infection, a temperature over 100.4 degrees Fahrenheit, or any other communicable disease, campers / counselors will be sent home. Campers must be fever free for 24 hours before returning to camp. Camp Playland reserves the right to request a negative Covid test in order for any ill camper / counselor to return to camp.

POSITIVE CASES – If a camper / counselor tests positive for COVID-19, they will isolate at home for 5 days, returning to camp on the 6th day if they are symptom free. Camp will notify close contacts of the positive case, including group mates and bus mates.

QUARANTINING – Exposed campers / counselors may continue to attend camp, regardless of vaccination status. <u>Please watch for symptoms</u> and stay home from camp if symptoms develop.

INDOOR AREAS / RAINY DAYS – As much as possible, activities will be held outdoors. On very rainy days groups will utilize covered pavilions and tents. Camp will function rain or shine.

BATHROOMS / DISINFECTING ACTIVITIES – Our maintenance staff do a great job keeping the campus clean. We also have designated bathroom cleaners on campus all day. At the end of each camp day custodians will sanitize and clean the entire campus.

CAMPER & COUNSELOR CLEANLINESS – There are many stations around campus for hand washing. Campers and counselors must wash hands with soap and water before eating and after using the restroom.
